## 2016 Embassy of Spain Scholarship Program

The Education Office of the Embassy of Spain (Washington) is proud to offer the opportunity to be the recipient of a **two week course in Salamanca, Spain to a Canadian secondary school, community college, or college Spanish teacher who is also a member of the OMLTA.**

**Location: Spanish Language Center MESTER, Salamanca**

***Tecnología y cultura en la clase de español***

**Dates: July 3-16, 2016**

The scholarship from the Embassy in Ottawa includes course fees, full board accommodation (university residence or host family), transfers from Madrid (Barajas airport)-Salamanca and return, and some cultural activities. The OMLTA will contribute \$500 to defray travel expenses upon successful completion of the program and submission of relevant receipts.

Please note that airfare from your home airport to Madrid, room upgrades/single supplements, medical insurance, and other incidentals are **not** covered in this scholarship. Please note that this course, while approved by the Education Office of the Embassy of Spain, is offered by a private language academy and does not count for university credits.

### Application Checklist:

- Résumé/Curriculum vitae
- 2 letters of reference:
  - 1 from your principal or designate (including reference to a minimum of **one year experience teaching Spanish** and at least three years teaching experience);
  - 1 from a colleague, parent, student, or other education professional
- Applicant letter of at least 200 words (double-spaced, 12 pt. font), in Spanish or English, including:
  - a brief outline of your teaching career, including courses taught (Spanish and others)
  - an explanation of how this opportunity would benefit your teaching,
  - reference to your OCT number.
- Must be a current OMLTA member (visit [www.omlta.org](http://www.omlta.org) to activate membership, if required)
