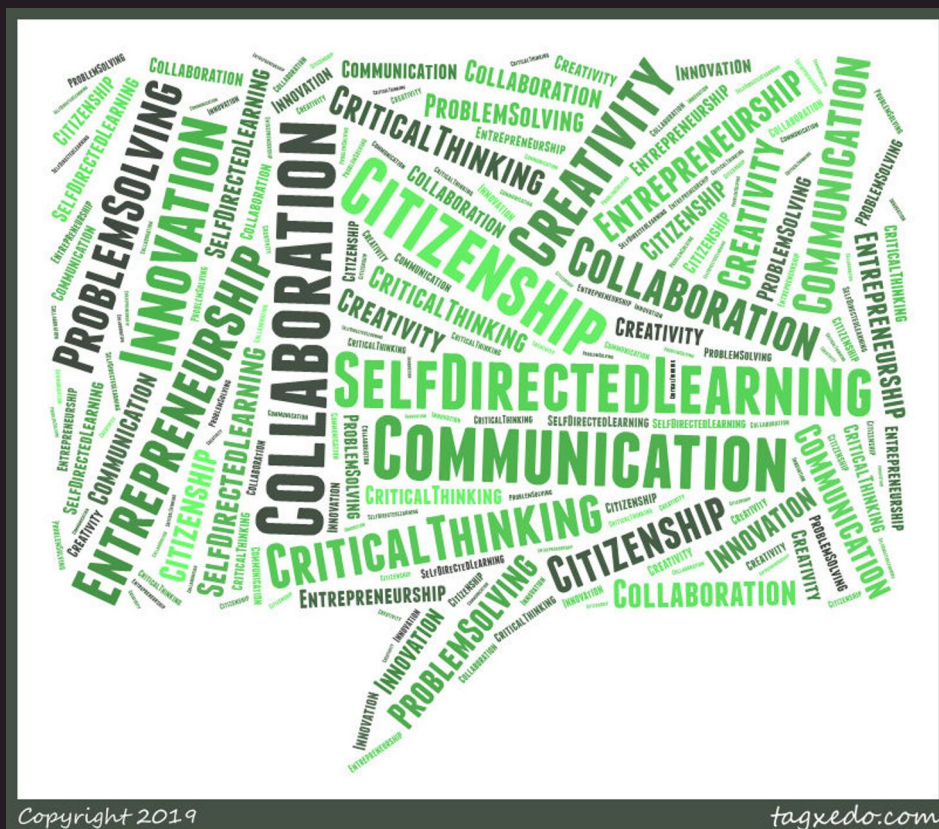

## WHY BECOME A SECOND LANGUAGE EDUCATOR?

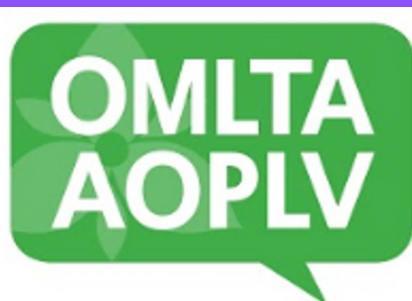
- Increase job opportunities
